


















To make your very own Knights Shield you will need:

This handy template (Print page 2 if you want shield with the Lion or page 3 to design your own shield)

I x A4 sheets of a white card or paper

Large Cardboard box

Scissors

Sticky tape or Glue Dots

Glue stick

Crayons, markers, or paint to decorate your shield

Please, make sure that you have a grown-up who can assist you, after all every knight had his squire (that is the trainee knight)



Step I: Print and cut out the template for your shield



Step 3: Cut along the lines you traced





Step 2: Place the template on top of the cardboard and trace around it with a pen or marker



Step 4: Cut a long strip of cardboardthis will be the handle of your shield











Step 5: Glue the Shield template to the cardboard shield
