



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


















To make your very own Knights Armour you will need:

This handy template (print pages 2,4,5 and 6 for Armour with Athlone Coat of Arms or 3,4,5 and 6 if you want to create your own design)

4 x A4 sheets of white card (200 gsm) or a regular paper and a large cardboard box.


Scissors

8 x split pins


Hole puncher

Crayons, markers, or paint to decorate your armour

Please, make sure that you have a grown-up who can assist you, after all every knight had his squire (that is the trainee knight)



Step I: Print out Template



Step 3: Punch holes (marked with o)



Step 2: Cut all the pieces out



Step 4: Colour your Armour









Step 5: Assemble Shoulders using split pins



Step 6: Assemble Armour using split pins
