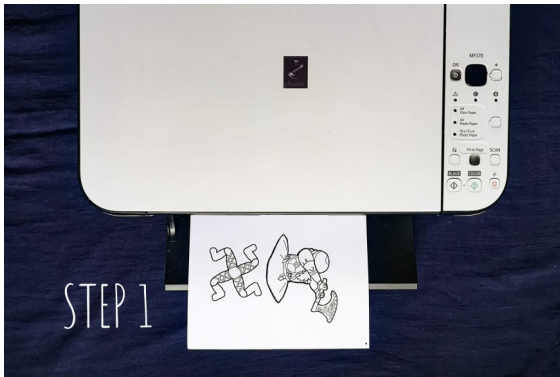


YOU WILL NEED:

- ♦ I A4 page of tin card on which to print our your Viking using our handy template.
Alternatively use a plain sheet of paper and a piece of cardboard (cereal box will be perfect)
- ♦ Scissors
- ♦ Colouring pencils or markers
- ♦ Some glue
- ♦ A piece of eraser or cork
- ♦ I push pin

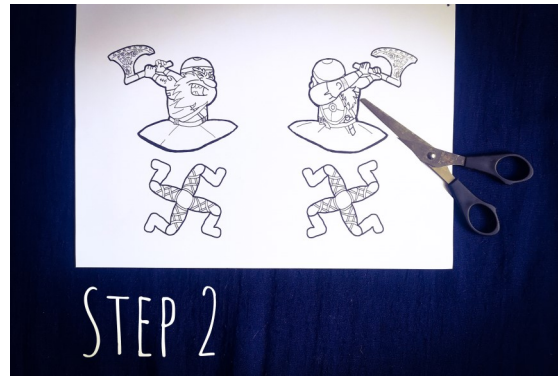
Note for parents:

A parent /guardian must be present to ensure the safety of the children using our craft tutorials. Parents will be required to maintain adequate supervision of their child while they are working on their Viking. Parents help may be needed with some children in preparing crafts, particularly when they need to use scissors.



Print your Viking (using our handy template) on a sheet of thin card.

If you don't have any thin card, you can print the template on to a plain sheet of paper and glue it to a piece of cardboard (See step 3*)



Cut out your Viking carefully.



Take the front and back cut-outs of your Viking and glue them together. This way your Viking will look good from all angles!



Glue the front of your Viking to the cardboard and cut it out again. Glue the back of your Viking to the other side. Repeat the same action for the legs.



Colour your Viking.



For this step you will need grown-up help.

Ask a grown-up to cut you a piece of eraser or cork



With a push pin attach the legs to the back of your Viking and secure it with the eraser or cork

WELL DONE!!!

Your Viking is now ready to run!
